## **Code of Conduct and Dress Standards**

1. **Dress Standards:** Clothing should be modest in fabric, fit and style, and should be appropriate for the occasion. A clean and well cared for appearance should be maintained. (Refer to Agenda for more information regarding the appropriate dress for each activity.)

**General Guidelines** (also refer to "For the Strength of Youth" pamphlet) here.

- \* No shirts with logos that conflict with church standards (i.e. beer or cigarette logos)
  - \* No short-shorts of any kind for any activity
  - \* For skirts or dresses, no slits above the knees
  - \* No exposed undergarments, or sagging pants
  - \* No shirts that do not cover the stomach (including when you raise your hand)
  - \* No clothing that does not cover the shoulder or is low-cut in the front or back
  - \* No tank tops, spandex or two-piece bathing suits
2. **Electronics:** No electronics of any kind will be allowed at the conference. This includes: Gameboys, Ipods, X-Box, CD players, or similar gaming and music electronics, etc. Cell phones brought by youth for emergency and family purposes must remain in the dorms at ALL times. Any cell phone usage (in dorms only) will be at the discretion and under the supervision of the Ward/Branch chaperones.
  3. **Word of Wisdom:** No drugs, tobacco, or alcohol or evidence of such on any person or on the premises.
  4. **Dancing:** Use the proper dance position and posture. Avoid extremes of body movement in fast dances. Keep some daylight between partners during slow dances.
  5. **Troy University Property:** Respect the Property of Troy University at all times. Avoid damage or abuse of any kind.
  6. **Honesty:** Do not take items that do not belong to you. If you find something that seems to be lost, turn it over to a chaperone or stake leader.
  7. **Treat others with Respect:** Treat others with respect and dignity. Be courteous and kind during the conference. Listen to the session leaders and avoid being disruptive. Abusive or vulgar language will no be tolerated in any circumstance.
